PINOT NOIR 2024 CENTRAL COAST

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2024 vintage began with a relatively dry winter that created an earlier bud break than 2023. A warmer April and cooler May provided excellent bloom and fruit set conditions. Mild weather prevailed through the summer, but a warm August and smaller heat waves in early September provided a perfect last push to ripeness and excellent picking conditions for Pinot Noir.

VINEYARD SOURCES

Formerly known as “Heritage” Pinot Noir, a majority of this blend (70%) comes from the San Luis Obispo Coast complimented by grapes from Santa Ynez, Sta Rita Hills and Santa Lucia Highlands. All four of these growing regions have a strong Pacific influence marked by foggy mornings and sunny, breezy afternoons, ideal conditions for Pinot Noir's long, slow ripening cycle. This extended hang time helps grapes develop complex flavors and retain natural acidity, while pronounced diurnal shifts preserve freshness and structure.

WINEMAKING

After harvest, grapes for this wine were optically sorted and then cold soaked for three days before fermentation at moderate temperatures in stainless steel tanks to emphasize fruit character. After fermentation, the wine was aged for six months in 74% French oak of which 22% was new and 26% in stainless steel tanks.

Sight	Medium light ruby red
Nose	Youthful aromas of pomegranate, Rainier cherry and cranberry accented by notes of vanilla pod, fennel and red licorice.
Palate	Medium bodied, focused flavors of cranberry, strawberry and red currant are mixed with notes of sun dried tomato, rhubarb and dusty earth.
